

Hi All,

One goal for this year is to report the trail accomplishments and upcoming work on an every other month basis.

Note: Much of the work is construction/re-construction (NOT MAINTENANCE) thus indicated by a high dollar cost/mile. This is due to the lack of work on trails over the last number of years and associated extreme natural events.

Trail Work Accomplishments January - March

Nogales (Ribbing)

- AZT (Nogales dist) continuing trail building (approx 1 mile total), 2 gates and some free work donated by SCC
- Atascosa trail work done by ACE to all 2.5 miles of this trail.
- Vualt Mine trail work done by ACE to all 2 miles of this trail.

Sierra Vista (Ribbing)

- Trail head signs replaced on Ida Canyon trail #110 and Sunnyside canyon trail #117
- AZT volunteer work to Sunnyside canyon trail to Parker lake, erosion control structures built with 7- 6x6 timbers (1.5 miles total)
- Brown Canyon ranch volunteer work, Erosion control features built with 10- 6x6 timbers (0.4 miles approx)
- petroglyphs close to Sunnyside canyon trail protected by small trail relocation. (0.1 miles)
- trail maintenance to John Cooper trail and Clark Spring trail by ACE (1.5 miles)
- Hazard tree removed from Miller canyon trail
